Important Announcement for Third-Year Bachelor's Students (Full-time and Part-time), Second-Year Master's Students (Full-time and Part-time), and Students Extending Their Studies in the 2024-2025 Academic Year

This announcement concerns students with outstanding exams from the first and second years of the Bachelor's program, and from the first year of the Master's program, during the second semester.

The academic calendar for 2024-2025 sets different exam periods for first and secondyear students compared to third-year students at the Bachelor's level, and for first-year compared to second-year students at the Master's level.

Students enrolled in the third year of the Bachelor's program or second year of the Master's program, including those extending their studies, who have outstanding subjects from previous years contracted in the 2024-2025 academic year (second semester), have the right to take these exams twice, according to the Transferable Credits Regulation. To exercise this right, students who do not pass an exam on the first attempt may retake it under a different form of study or specialization during **June 10–15**, **2025**.

Students wishing to use this option must:

Carefully review the exam schedule posted on the faculty website at https://tbs.ubbclui.ro/student/examene-date-de-examen

Submit a **written application to the Secretariat** between **June 10 and June 13, 2025**, specifying their chosen options. The application form is available on the faculty website at https://tbs.ubbcluj.ro/.

Note that subjects with a colloquium as the examination form will be held during the last week of classes (June 2–7, 2025). Students may take the exam on the first scheduled date and, if necessary, retake it on the second date without submitting an application.

Failure to submit the application for retaking exams under a different specialization or form of study may result in the instructor denying access to the exam.

Additionally, the outstanding exam fee must be paid no later than May 18, 2025, via the Academic Info platform. Students who do not pay by this deadline will not be permitted to take the exams.
