Announcement of the selection of students for the programme " *Mastering EU Influence: Practical Lobbying and Networking in Brussels*"

The selection is open for undergraduate students, in order to occupy 4 places within the **Blended Mobility with Short-Term Physical Mobility program: "Mastering EU Influence: Practical Lobbying and Networking in Brussels"**. The program is organized by **EPHEC Brussels**, Belgium, and will take place between **March 9-13, 2026**.

Eligibility criteria:

- **Knowledge of English** at a minimum B2 level (compulsory);
- **Knowledge in:** business negotiation, intercultural context, business communication;
- Students enrolled at bachelor's level, 2nd or 3rd year, in AA programs taught in Romanian or English;
- The average obtained in the previous semester will be a tie-breaker criterion.

- Interview (70%)
- Average obtained in the previous semester (Candidates do not need to request certificates with averages from the secretariat, as they will be requested directly by the selection committee) (30%)
