



ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING RE-ENROLMENT FOR THE 2026–2027 ACADEMIC YEAR

Students who wish to re-enrol for the 2026–2027 academic year must complete the **re-enrolment application form**, available on the Faculty of Business website, and submit it by email to secretariat.tbs@ubbcluj.ro no later than **6 September 2026, 23:59**.

The application must be accompanied by:

- proof of payment of the RON 400 re-enrolment fee (in accordance with the 2026–2027 Tuition and administrative fees regulations);
- proof of payment of any outstanding fees from previous academic years during which the student was enrolled in a study programme at Babeș-Bolyai University, as follows: tuition fees, for students who have not previously been re-enrolled; outstanding fees for previously contracted and unpaid failed courses (equivalent to the tuition fee) - for students who have been re-enrolled in previous academic years.

The tuition fee will consists of:

- the fees corresponding to failed courses from previous academic years (failed exams);
- any applicable fees for courses from subsequent years of study that the student requests to be included in the Study contract.

These fees must be paid by **5 December 2026** for the first semester and by **15 May 2027** for the second semester. After these deadlines, a late payment penalty of 0.04% for each day of delay will be applied.

After the re-enrolment application has been approved, students must submit (in person or by courier) the following documents to the Faculty of Business Registrar's Office:

- For Bachelor's programmes: High school diploma (Baccalaureate Diploma) and Academic record – original;
- For Master's programmes: High school diploma (Baccalaureate Diploma) and Academic record – original; Bachelor's degree diploma and Diploma supplement – original.
- Birth certificate – copy;
- Identity Card/Passport – copy;



- One passport-size photograph (to be submitted to the Secretariat of the Faculty of Business after the beginning of the academic year).

To be eligible for re-enrolment, students must have paid all outstanding financial obligations from previous academic years.
